## Lockdown Scenario

Many people buy their monthly medicines from Government hospitals as they are available free of cost. People below poverty who do not have cars and bikes, but needs medicines from Government hospitals are struggling to get their regular medicines due to Corona Lockdown. Moreover, the medicines which are available near them in private medical shops are costly which they can't afford to buy.

### EXAMPLE

 Venkatesan is a 70 year old man, who must take 5 tables each day to maintain his blood pressure level. He usually gets medicine from the Government hospital (free of cost medicines), as he has very limited income. But, in this lockdown period, he is unable to travel to get medicines as there is no public transport available. So, he is getting sick rapidly without having his regular medicines.



## **Problem Identified**

### **PROBLEM DESCRIPTION**

People getting their regular monthly medicines from Government hospitals without paying any penny for the medicine are suffering to get their monthly medicine as they are unable to travel to government hospitals since public transports are banned due to COVID-19 lockdown. Secondly, the medicines in private medical shops in their areas are costly for them.

### WHY IS IT AN URGENT PROBLEM?

According to a study published in a health-care journal, many patients are badly hit by lockdown and 80% patients are struggling for diagnosis and medicines




## **Solution**


### MOBILE MEDICAL DURING LOCKDOWN

Most of the people under poverty level are neither able to travel to government hospitals to get their pharmaceutical needs nor afford to buy medicines in private hospitals. If mobile medicals are arranged in every area, which will travel to every street on scheduled bases, then people can get their regular medicines at their door steps.

Here people neither have to travel long to get medicine, nor spend lot of money in private medicals shops. This medicines will be available to those who already are registered patients in government hospitals and also have a prescription written by a doctor working in government hospitals.


## **Process**

The patient just have to display his patient number/ID card, here the computer system will display all the details of the medicines which the patient was having earlier, and thus the pharmacist in the mobile medicals will issue the same medicines which can be consumed for a particular period.
