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Problem Identified

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

More than 1 million children experienced the death of one or both parents during the first 14 months of the pandemic.

In India, an estimated 1.19 lakh children lost a primary caregiver one or both parents, or one or both custodial grandparents. Among them, 1.16 lakh lost one or both parents.

Children who have lost a parent or caregiver are at risk of profound short- and long-term adverse effects on their health, safety, and wellbeing, such as increasing the risk of disease, physical abuse, sexual violence, and adolescent pregnancy.

1. **Personal Level** - How might Kiran (age 10) needs financial help for his education and ensure his safety and wellbeing.
2. **Systems Level** - Amit (age 5) lost his both parents from Covid. How can the gov help Amit's legal guardian to get a vaccination to avoid further disease or loss?



Urgency/Importance

WHY IS IT AN URGENT PROBLEM?

We urgently need to identify the children behind these numbers and develop a care system, so that every child can be given the support they need to thrive.

And societies need to help families affected by the pandemic with economic, educational and mental health support.

SOLUTIONS & IDEAS

Solution 1: Care volunteers

Accessing COVID data from the local hospital and visit deceived person's family and collect information about the guardian and the children wellbeing and education details from Tier 2 and Tier 3 city.

Solution 2: Setting up a help centers & emergency helpline

A help kiosk in each area/location in collecting the information and share it with the child welfare system, NGO, Gov for Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities

Solution 3: A digital app/service to save children

Creating an app or a service that will help children in assisting their wellbeing and education from the local community, gov/private backed NGO around them.

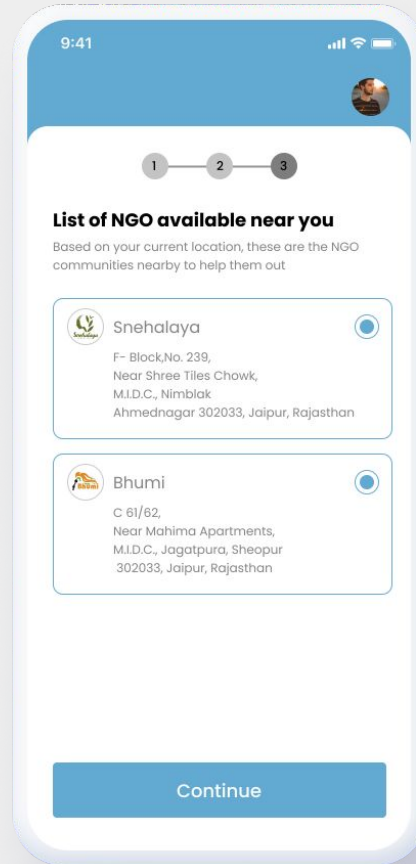
Final Solution & Innovation

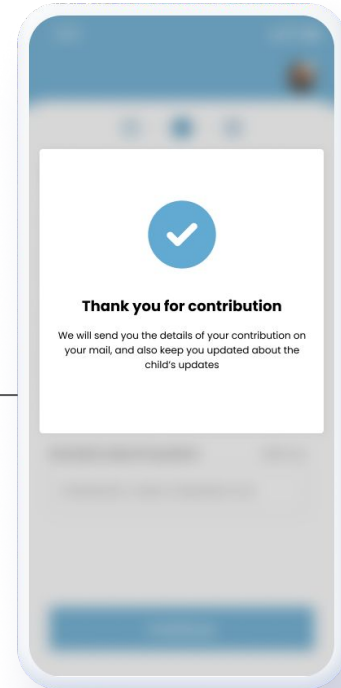
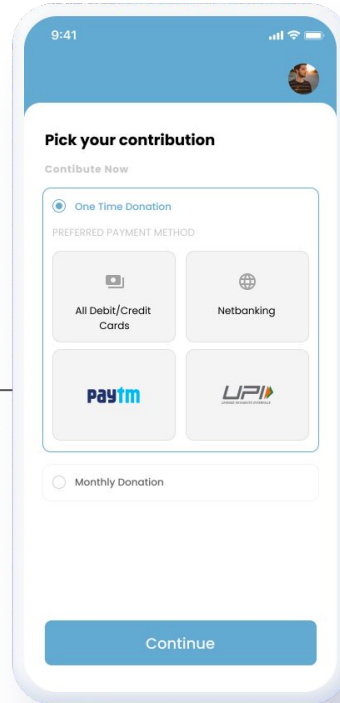
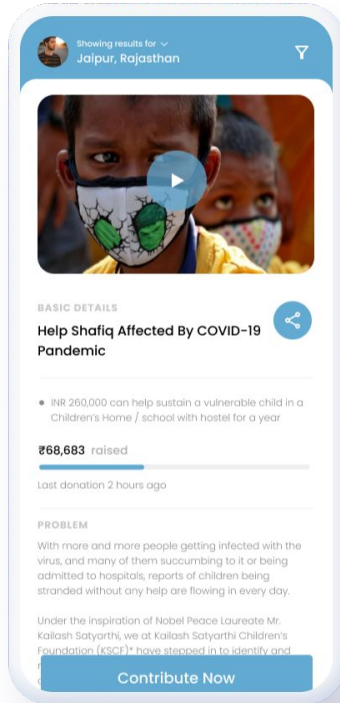

Design Process

Discovery - We began by broadly exploring and researching the numerous problem areas experienced by people who lost their loved ones during COVID and which affected their and children's lively hood

Primary & secondary research - We conducted few interviews with families who are having kids on different age groups by understanding their problems and challenges. Did synthesis, created high level journey's to derive major findings.

Identifying the problem - We then clustered the problems into larger buckets and voted on problem areas that resonated with us to identify a problem area we would like to work on.

Ideate & derive solution - The insights were used to get directions and generate ideas to finally derive at the solution. Later, the solution was detailed out – mapped features, created task flows, defined styles and interactions, created prototype.
